Ann's Creative Corner Project #751: Fall Trees and Leaves!

- Use a photo copy of the tree trunk and branches of a tree
- Or you may like to cut out a brown tree trunk and some brown branches from construction paper.
- Glue your tree pieces onto another piece of paper.
- With either of these methods, provide some colourful leaf shapes to glue onto the "Tree"
- Alternatively, you may just use scraps of ripped coloured paper to glue onto your tree shape.
- Glue some falling leaves on the base of your creation.
- Try using some stamps of leaf shapes.
- Some sticker leaves may be used but this is less creative.
- Draw your own leaves too. They can be any shape or size.
- Add details to your creation such as the earth, grass and sky

Activity: Walk and collect Fall Leaves!

This can be a group or a family walk with baskets of leaves. Dry them out in various ways such as freshly laid out or press between a heavy book.
