## Ann's Creative Corner Project #753: Acorns!

- Provide the base shape of the acorn.
- Create the "Hat" shape.
- Or provide the entire shape of the acorn.
- Using two different shades of brown construction paper are good for this project as it defines the way the acorn is made.
- First you may like to add some lines to the hat part such as criss cross lines.
- The body of the acorn is smooth so lines may be optional if the child wishes to draw on the entire acorn that is fine too.
- Attach the "hat" to the body of the acorn using a glue stick.
- If you would like to add some texture to this, try adding some bits of nature to it such as pieces of dried leaves.
- Texture may be added with tissue paper too.
- Maybe a paper leaf for the top would be an option.
- If you make a larger acorn, try making two pieces and staple and stuff the acorn shape with the scrap paper for a 3D look!

## **Activity: Nature walk**

Go walking and find acorns and chestnuts. Compare the shapes and sizes of the two nuts. Take the top off the acorn. Break the chestnut to see what's inside.
