### Project #759: Halloween Ghosts!

- Cut out a ghost shape from white paper.
- Place eyes and an oval mouth created with black paper or draw with a black Felt marker or Crayon.
- You may like to add other details to your paper ghost as well.
- Ideas could be cotton, sparkles, confetti, tissue paper or perhaps paint could be done with a fine paint brush or QTip.
- Many ghosts could also be placed on a black piece of construction paper to create a ghost scene!
- Another idea is to make tissue or paper towel ghosts.
- Place a scrunched up paper towel into the center of another, fold and pinch it tight. Tape or tie a string around the scrunched part to form the ghost's head. *OR USE COFFEE FILTERS*
- Use felt markers to create facial details.
