- Provide some white crayons for children to draw some details on the wings and possibly the facial details
- If you make the bat large, you may be able to provide some sticker eyes or googly eyes for children to glue on. (googly eyes are not for Toddlers as they can be a choking hazard)
- If you make smaller bats, you may like to make a mobile by tying your small bats to a hangar or stick. They may blow and wiggle a little if placed by a window or a fan.
- Try making a collage of bats to make a night scene for your bats.
- Add some sparkles for stars.
- Add some star stickers.
- Try some stamps as well.
