Project #756: Harvest and Corn Stalks!

- Cut out the shape of a corn on the cob on yellow construction paper.
- Cut out some leafy looking corn stalks to place around the corn.
- Children may glue these pieces together or glue them onto another piece of paper to make a corn or farm scene as well
- Try using some natural fibers such as the real dried parts of the corn stalk! Glue these onto your project.
- See if you can attach some dried corn onto this project as well.
- Scrunched yellow and green tissue paper may also look good and add texture to your Corn in the Stalk Craft.
- Add some magazine or calendar pictures into your project if you like. This would be great as a group project as well.
- Make a corn maze as a group project on a large poster board.

Activities for Food:

Boil the corn on the cob.

Cut the corn off the cob.

Try buying a can of corn. It is preserved quite well in a can too.

Make some popcorn as this is dried corn!

Go to a corn maze to walk around!
