Ann's Creative Corner Project #757: Apples and Apple Trees!

- Make some apple prints from paint!
- Colour an apple tree shape and also you may like to glue the apple shapes onto your tree.
- Have some real apples for samples while you are creating your project.
- Cut our magazine and calendar pictures of apple trees, apples and orchards.
- Make a collage with your cut out pictures.
- Have some real photos of apples and trees and try to draw one yourself.
- Use tissue paper to add texture to your apples.
- Add a stem and some leaves to your apples.
- Please do not use real apples for prints as this is considered wasting food.

Activity: Apple Sauce!

Peel and cut apples into small pieces. Be sure there are no seeds in the apple pieces. Place the apple pieces in a pot. Cover with water and slowly simmer the apples until they are mushy. While cooking the apples, be sure to mash them down with a masher. Do not use too much water as they will create their own water. Add some cinnamon while cooking. Sugar is optional but usually does not need it as the apples have plenty of flavour. Cinnamon also adds flavour and some sweetness.
