- Pumpkins and Acorns!
- Make the shapes of these items.
- Use finger prints to make a design on the shapes.
- Try this as a family or a group project.
- Add names to the finger prints you make.
- Cut out pumpkin shaped paper as well.
- Design these by adding scraps of paper to make the Jack O -Lantern!
- Use stickers if you like.
- Add some sparkles.
- Add tissue paper
- Add natural items such as outdoor dried leaves.

Activity: Pumpkin Carving and Seeds!

An adult may cut the top of the pumpkin open with an opening large enough to scoop out the seeds from the inside. When done, the seeds may be placed on a baking sheet with a little salt on them. Bake for 20-30 minutes at a medium temperature. Check routinely to see when they turn a light brown. Take out and let cool. Enjoy Eating them!
