Project #765: Poppies for Remembrance Day!

- Cut out a poppy shape.
- Place this onto a coffee filter by glueing it on.
- If you would like to add details and make a larger poppy, use 4 hearts to add to each circumference of your poppy circle or shape.
- Add a black circle into the middle for the Center of your poppy.
- Add some red tissue paper to the outer areas of the coffee filter if you like as this will give it some texture.
- You may like to add a green and black circle as we often see poppies designed like this.
- Try some bingo dabbers in the coffee filter area. Various shades of reds or purples would be nice for this area.

Activity: Go to shopping areas to find the poppies which will be ready for purchase by donation. Talk to your children about the meaning of Remembrance Day and the compassion for the soldiers. Read books on this. Read poetry "In Flanders Fields".
