Project #766: Remembrance Day Wreaths & Headbands!

- Cut the centre out of a paper plate to form a wreath.
- Add some poppy shapes and leaf shapes to decorate. Use tissue paper for texture and a black circle to place in the center of the poppies.
- Cut a strip of Poster Board paper that is about 5cm or 2 inches wide and about 30 cm or 1 foot long. Maybe longer depending on the circumference of the child's head.
- Cut out some poppy shapes or make the poppy shapes with the children.
- Attach them to the headband with a glue stick or tape. Staples can also be used but place the smooth side of the staple to the inside of the headband for comfort of the children. Be sure the outer staples are secure and not poking out as this may cause scratches to oneself or others.
- Try drawing on your poppies.
- Add some sparkles or red tissue paper to your poppies.
- When you are done, measure the headband to fit the child's head and tape together in place to fit the child.

Activity: Poppy Seed Cupcakes

Make a white cake recipe and add some poppy seeds into the batter before baking. When the cupcakes are cooled, place some red icing on them, top this off with some edible sprinkle decorations or special poppy shaped trims.
