Ann's Creative Corner Project #771: Igloo Art!

- Create an igloo shape from white paper.
- Glue this onto another piece of paper such as light or dark blue. Black is also good if you would like a night sky.
- Children may add some details of the lines of the igloo as they are made from large packed snow squares.
- These squares or cubes could also be made from packaging paper such as the white foam paper or the bubble paper is also a nice texture.
- Bubble paper may be used for other areas such as a frozen pond for example.
- In the arch of the igloo which is the doorway, you may like to draw or glue in a penguin or people.
- Stickers may be nice for this especially for the younger Toddlers and Preschoolers.
- Add some cotton for the snow on the igloo or around the igloo to make a texture look.
- Add some snowy trees to your creation.

Activity: Ice Play!

Freeze water in various containers to create shapes of Ice Cubes or larger items such as blocks of ice. Put the ice in a water table play area or individual plastic bowls. Supple some spoons.

Add some salt and see what happens! Add some warm water and see what happens! Add paint or food colouring.....
