Project #769: Fun with Shapes and Colours!

- Cut out strips of various colours of tissue paper.
- Place these strips onto a piece of waxed paper. Glue them in place. They may be overlapping each other to see the changes in colours..
- Try this with some cellophane paper of various colours.
- If you use tissue paper, try adding a tiny bit of food colouring with an eyedropper. Watch it spread as it changes the colours
- If you would like to try a coffee filter, they are very absorbent. Drops of food colouring work well on the coffee filters. Please place the coffee filter into a recycle plastic container before adding the food colouring. You may also like to wear a paint shirt over clothes as the food colouring may stain clothes. Place a mat on the floor or area around the project as well.
- This may also be done with poster paint as the children may dip a small brush into the water and the paint to paint a white piece of paper. Watch the colours change!

Activities: "Construction coloured see through magnets"

If you have access to see through coloured magnets, they can be overlapped to see the colour changes. May various shapes and houses/buildings. There are also some 3D plastic shapes available in stores to build with. Try wooden blocks such as in a puzzle block. Do some counting and naming of the colours!
