Project #773: Gingerbread People Art!

- Cut the shape of a gingerbread man.
- Or these may be bought as precut from a Dollar Store.
- Provide the children with a variety of materials such as Wool, sticker eyes, googly eyes (Preschool age plus) sparkles, crayons, felt markers etc.
- Children may enjoy being creative in their own fashion.
- The Gingerbread person can be themselves, a family member, a friend, or another character of their choice.
- Write a note on the back of the Gingerbread shape as to who this gingerbread person reflects.
- If the Preschooler can print, please have them practice printing on the back of the shape.
- Stamps for printing may also be used as this may help those children learn the letters to print.

Activity: Ginger Bread Cookies!

Find a recipe of your choice to create your gingerbread cookies! The children may help with the measuring and mixing of the ingredients. Also the children can choose the cookie cutters. They may choose another shapes and not for the ginger bread cookies. These cookies could also be sugar cookies or shortbread cookies. A sample is chocolate shortbread cookies by adding Cocoa! Decorate your cookies! Use firm icing to allow candies to stick to the cookies!
