Ann's Creative Corner Project #774: Christmas Trees and Bells!

(Kids Care Preschool Project)

- Provide the shape of an evergreen tree and some bell shapes.
- For the Bell shapes prepare the cut out, plus place a piece of tape at the top. Punch a hole in the taped area to ensure a strong area for threading.
- Provide various colours of ribbon or sting.
- Thread this through the hole and create a tie for the bell to hang.
 Be sure the loop is small so it will be a non choking hazard.
- Children may decorate the trees and the bells in anyway they like.
- Use items such as felt markers, sparkles, stickers, cotton, tissue paper, confetti etc.
- The trees can be Christmas trees or also they could be a snowy tree with cotton glued on. The cotton balls can be stretched to make them easier to glue on and less waste. They are also fluffy when pulled and reshaped for your project.
- Paint them on an easel! Do this side by side as well!

Activity: Go on a tree walk!

This is a good time to take a nature walk to view the evergreen trees in their natural state. Then you may wish to go to view them at a garden center. Also view them in a mall or a store as "Christmas Trees" Note the changes!
