Ann's Creative Corner Project # 775: Candy Cane Art!

- Make a paper candy cane shape.
- Provide various strips of coloured paper for the "Stripes" of the candy cane.
- Cover the Candy cane shape with glue such as a glue stick.
- Children may glue the strips pf coloured paper onto the Candy Cane paper shape.
- This can also be done with short strips of "pipe cleaners"
- Traditional candy canes are red and white.
- Various colours are nice too.
- Trim the edges as needed to form the candy cane shape evenly.
- You also like to make candy canes from the coloured "pipe cleaner fuzzy wires" by twisting two colours together and then bending one end to form the "Hook" for the candy cane shape.

Activity: Candy Cane Walk at Circle Time

Place some small square mats on the floor. Place some paper or real candy canes on some of the mats. Play some music. Children walk around the mats. When the music stops, the children stop by the mat they are at. If there is a candy cane, they pick it up. Those children may then sit down. Continue the game until each child has a candy cane.
