Project #776: Christmas Stars!

(Kids Care Preschool Project)

- Cut out a variety of sizes of Star Shapes out of Yellow construction paper.
- As children start the craft, ask them what they wish for Christmas or a Holiday gift.
- Write it on the star plus their name. If children can print, they may print it themselves.
- Stamps may also be used such as individual letter stamps to spell their name.
- After the name and wish list: Provide children with glue sticks.
- Children may put glue all over the star/s or some children may like to place just a small amount of glue on them.
- Provide some shakers of sparkles to sprinkle on the stars.
- This could be a group project as well as all stars can be on one tray as the children sprinkle sparkle over them.
- If individual stars, be sure to place the star in a recycle container before sprinkling the glitter. This saves the glitter for future use and also may be used to "Dip" the star in.
- Attach a string or ribbon when dry if you would like to hang them up.
