Project #777: Santa Hats!

(By Kids Care Preschool)

- Cut out red strips of poster board about 2 inches wide and long enough to measure around the child's head.
- Provide a red santa hat shape which can be foam if you have some or it could also be poster board.
- Provide a white strip about 1 inch wide of felt or you may use some cotton.
- Place the hat shape onto the long red strip. Glue this on or you may tape it or staple it.
- Children may then attach the white strip to the hat as shown below. This may require some non-toxic liquid white glue to be sure it adheres properly. You may staple the white strip on if you are using felt as it may not stick with glue.
- Children may decorate the hat with sparkles, stickers, felt markers, glitter and possibly some natural items such as Evergreen tree pine needles or pieces of pine cones.
- Try some tissue paper on the hat if you like. Try wallpaper or other types of paper too.
- Attach cotton or a pom pom to the tip of the hat. Tape may work best.
- Measure the strip of the hat shape onto the child's head and staple.

Activity: Santa Parade!

Play some festive music as the children show off their Santa hats! Do some actions to various Santa songs.
