Project #778: Pine Cone Trees!

(By Kids Care Preschool)

- Gather some pine cones of various sizes
- Provide pom, pom, cotton balls, sparkles and may some white paint if you like.
- Using non-toxic liquid white glue, cover the pine cones with it.
- Attach the pom, poms, cotton and the sparkles.
- Think of painting the pine cones white.
- A nice display on a Recycle Reusable plastic tray or dish would make a nice Display piece.
- You may also like to add natural items such as evergreen small branches and some pine needles.
- Perhaps you may find pine cones with seeds. The seeds could also be part of your display piece.
- Try adding some ribbons or other items you may like for your scene. Cotton for "Snow" would look good.
- Attach a sting if you would like to hang these pine cones up.

Activity: Pine Cone Hunt!

Before starting this project, go for a walk with the children to find various pine cones and evergreen pieces for the project. When you bring them indoors, allow them to dry for a day or two before starting the project!
