Project #786: Winter Sports Ice Skates!

- Cut out the shape of an ice skate from poster board paper.
- These may also be cut for boxes such as packaging boxes, show boxes, cereal boxes etc. This is a good way to use these items that are recycled.
- Punch holes with a hole punch to thread a "lace" though. This can be string, wool or thin shoelaces.
- Children may string the laces through the holes to form a "tie" for the "laces".
- If you make two skates, they may be tied together to make a pair of skates.
- Children may also draw on their skates, add stickers, add textured materials etc.
