Project #787: Snowflakes!

- Use a Coffee filter.
- Fold the coffee filter to various sizes being sure that it is thin enough for snipping with scissors.
- Snip small pieces out of the filter.
- A hole punch may also be used.
- Open your filter wide to see the type of snow flake you created.
- This may also be done with plain white paper cut into a circle, triangle, or any shape you like.
- Fold the paper, snip and open!
- Paper or filter may also be decorated first such as with sparkles or thin stickers!
- Snowflakes may also be painted with sparkles after they are cut out and opened.

Chant: "Snow is Falling Down" (actions with fingers)

Twirling, Swirling, Twirling Swirling!

Snow if falling down. Poof!
