### **Project #782: Christmas Stockings and Wrap!**

- Make a stocking shape from construction paper.
- You like to have two stocking shapes if you would like to staple them together so as to have a slot in the center.
- Provide markers, crayons, stickers etc.
- Cotton may be used for the top of the stocking to form the opening top of the stocking shapes.
- For older children and some preschool age children, you may like to punch holes with a hole puncher on the edges for the children to weave a festive shiny ribbon or string through.
- Think of other ideas such as bingo dabbers, Qtip painting, Stamping pad shapes.
- If you have some Christmas stamping pads, you may also like to place stamps of some plain brown paper that will create some wrapping paper! (Old Fashioned Idea!)

#### **Activities:**

Use your wrapping paper to wrap gifts.

Place items in your stockings if you have two strung or stapled together!
