Project #783: Bears!

- Copy onto paper or cut out a bear shape.
- The bear may be a climbing pose or a standing on four paws shape
- Children may draw and colour bear.
- Add the facial features with drawing, sticker eyes or glue on paper circular paper pieces and fill in the pupil of the eye.
- Add some stretched cotton balls for the bear's fur if you are making a polar bear.
- If you are making a black, brown or grizzly bear, provide some brown and black wool pieces.
- For a Panda bear, you may like to use the black and white shapes to form the panda's body.
- Glue the bear onto a piece of construction paper.
- Create a scene around the bear or bears.
- Add trees, landscape, ice shapes, caves etc.

Song: "Going on a Bear Hunt" (please look up words)

Use actions while chanting the words.

Actions could be seeing a tree (climbing), grass (swishing), river (swimming), Cave (Shhh..)

Then you see the bear with nose, eyes, mouth, teeth and run home.
