- Look for various magazine or calendar winter trees and landscapes.
- Find tree shapes as well.
- Create your trees with bits and pieces of shaped tree trunks and branches.
- Glue these together on your paper which may have scenery on it as well.
- If you have a nice calendar full picture, you may like to add some small hand made trees.
- Add cotton for texture as it could be snowy.
- Add some bubble paper to create ice.
- Cut some waxed paper to create icicles.
- Use shapes for buildings or houses.
- A pond or lake could be made from construction paper.
- Try painting your scenery with a small paint brush or QTip dabbed in white paint.

Activity: Go for a nature walk. Look at the trees and the mountains. Look for signs of snow. Look at the deciduous trees and the evergreen trees and note the difference. Some have leaves and some don't!
