Project #800: Colours and Shapes Collage

- Provide a variety of paper shapes for the art.
- These shapes can be random shapes as well as standard shapes such as Squares, Triangles, Rectangles, diamonds, Circles etc.
- Provide a plain piece of paper.
- Children may create designs by glueing the shapes on to create what they like.
- Ideas can be making houses for example. However, this should not be promoted too much as it is the child's project to create what they like.
- Add some drawings into this after the glue dries. Glue Sticks are best as they dry fast.
- Use some texture paper as well for a 2D or 3D look.
- Tissue paper is nice if they are adding water, grass, sky etc to their creation.
- Or just a random cluster of colours is great too.
- Add some sparkles, glitter glue, a little paint with QTips may be nice and creative.

Activity: Shapes Freeze Dance!

Place some carpet or foam shapes onto the floor. Be sure they are secured and not slippery. Play some music. Stop the music. The children must stop on a shape and name the shape or colour of it.
