Project #792: Chinese Lanterns!

- Create the shape of a Chinese lantern using red construction paper.
- Draw some lines from side to side to form the curves of the Chinese lantern.
- Place some tape at the top and bottom of the lantern.
- Punch a hole in the taped area.
- Children may decorate or colour the lantern in anyway they like using felt markers, pencils and crayons
- Add some stickers if you like.
- Place some glue on it using a glue stick.
- Sprinkle sparkles onto the glued area.
- When the lantern is complete and dry, attach shiny ribbons to the top and the bottom. The top ribbon should be one that is tied together for hanging. The bottom ribbons should be free hanging as decorative.
- You may also like to use construction paper strips for the bottom of your lantern.

Activity: Dance with your lanterns. Learn some Chinese dancing. Wear your favourite chinese outfit.
