### Project #795: Valentines, Valentines!

- Cut out various heart shapes from pink, red, purple and other colours you may like. Traditionally, valentines are red and pink.
- These are easily made by folding the paper in half and cutting half of a heart shape on the fold of the paper.
- Open the paper and you have a heart. These can be various sizes and can be wide, narrow, long, short etc.
- Try cutting the edges in a swervey fashion, or use zigzag scissors. Try cutting jagged triangle shapes on edges too.
- Place a pretty doily in the center.
- Place various other small hearts within the large heart,
- Decorate with sparkles, stickers, and drawings.
- Try placing some stamps on it such as heart shapes or other shapes.
- Write on it or stamp your name.
- Try making a To: and From: and Love from: etc. as these large hearts may be Valentines Cards.
- Place a wrapped chocolate inside if this is a gift card.
