Project #796: Valentines Vases and Cards!

- Cut out a vase shape from wallpaper or construction paper or you may like to try waxed paper.
- Glue this onto another piece of construction paper.
- Add lines or stems to the opening top part of the vase shape.
- Add some paper Valentines that could be made from cutting scraps of paper.
- Attach the paper hearts to the stems.
- Write To and From on this "Card" if you like to give it to someone.
- Another idea is to use some Playdough in a small vase shaped jar or tin.
- Add some paper heart shapes that you may attach to pipe cleaners. These can be placed easily into the playdough in the jar.
- You may also like to add flower shapes.

Valentines sharing game

Create 3 Valentine Heart Shapes out of some Poster Board. Children may help decorate these Hearts with drawings, stickers, sparkles etc. These three Valentines will be a game. Or many smaller valentines. Place the Valentines in the Center. Chant:

"Valentines, valentines, red, pink and purple (or colours you choose)
I'll find a nice one a give it to you" (child gives someone one valentine)
Repeat till all have a turn at the game.
