Project #799: Colour Wheel!

- Cut out wedges/triangles of paper from a large Circle.
- These are RED, YELLOW and BLUE.
- These should be 1/3 of the circle to fit snugly in a circular shape.
- Glue these onto the large Circle Shape.
- These are your primary colours for the colour wheel.
- Next Cut out Purple, Orange and Green wedges that will fit in between the other wedges. These are the secondary colours. (they should be half the width of the primary colours.
- Glue these in between the other wedges.
- Orange goes in between red and yellow as red and yellow make orange.
- Green goes in between yellow and blue as yellow and blue make green.
- Purple goes in between red and blue as red and blue make purple.
- If you would like to continue the project, the children or adults may like to write the names of the colours on each wedge.

Activity: Mixing Colours with Food Colouring!

Pour a small amount of water into a clear plastic or glass jar

Try adding various combinations of drops of food colouring. View the results. Try the primary first, then the secondary.

If all colours become mixed you will get brown so go slowly to see the various changes first.
