- Add some string or wool for the hair if you like.
- Try some small stickers for details on clothing.
- Sticker eyes may be used as well.
- Try some googly eyes for children who are over 3 years old. This can be a choking hazard so not meant for toddlers or babies.
- Try adding some textured materials such as felt or cloth pieces.
- If you would like to make a scene; glue you people onto another piece of paper (construction paper)
- Make a group project, where family and friends make a large poster together with a poster board paper.
- Add some scenery details maybe
- Add some animals or pets.
