Project #803: Faces!

- Provide children with a variety of sizes of circles.
- Ask them to draw some facial features on these circles
- Ideas can be Happy, Joyful, Proud, Sad, Hurt, Excited, Worried, Scared, Blissful and other feelings you may think of.
- Provide Sticker eyes or they can draw eyes.
- This may also be made from Felt pieces where the adult or older child may use a glue gun or Non Toxic White Glue to glue facial features on the Felt Circles. Use these on a felt board or felt pillow!
- Try some lightweight cardboard such as a Tissue Paper box.
- If you make the light weight Cardboard Circular faces, you may like to attach these to a popsicle stick by Taping the faces onto a popsicle stick. These can be puppets!
