### Project #801: Pink Shirt Days!

- Create a basic shape of a pink shirt.
- Children may trace and cut this shape if they are older.
- Younger children can glue the precut Pink Shirt Shape onto another piece of paper.
- Children may add button shapes, drawings, stickers and stamps to create a shirt of their own design.
- Try adding textured materials such as pieces of cloth or felt strips.
- Try some wool and other strings as well. Pom poms as well!
- If the children like, they may add a head and body to the pink shirt as well.
- You may also want to start with a template of a person and place the shirt onto the person to glue it on.
- Add other clothing as you like such as pants, skirts, shoes and socks.
- Facial details too.
- Make a family portrait of Pink Shirts!
- Make a Friendship portrait of Pink Shirts!
