Project #805: Clouds!

- Cut out various cloud shapes. Most clouds are white but also could be grey or light blue!
- Cut out some rain drop shapes.
- Cut out a round yellow circle for the sun if you like.
- Children may glue these shapes onto a piece of construction paper. Blue is a good colour for the sky.
- Glue the raindrops under the cloud shapes.
- Add some soft cotton to the clouds.
- Cotton is nice when stretched and also when stretched is light weight, easier to apply and less waste.
- Please use the glue stick or liquid glue onto paper and then place the cotton on.
- Try white paint with a QTip.
- White or grey smaller bingo dabbers could also make the rain.
- Try making wispy lines so the clouds may be blowing.
- Try wispy lines for the wind and the rain.
- If you add the sun, add the rays as well.
- A rainbow could also be added as when it rains and is sunny it may create a Rainbow!
