Project #814: Planting Flowers!

- Provide small flower pots for seedling flowers.
- Provide seedling flowers such as marigolds or other basic flowers such as petunias or pansies.
- Place a small amount of soil in the bottom of the pot. This soil may be purchased at a garden center or store that has a gardening area.
- Place seedling in the pot.
- Carefully fill in the edges with more soil.
- Water this and place it on a warm patio or inside if it is too cold outdoors.
- On a patio, it should be slightly sheltered but also have the warmth of the sun to grow.
- Water it daily just a little so as not to over water it..

Activity: Replant the flower/s

When the flower reaches its fill in the pot, the roots will be intertwined. This will need to be replanted into a larger pot or garden. Pull the flower from the small pot by its base carefully so as not to break it. Plant into a larger pot or the garden carefully. Tend to it daily with water and pull any unwanted "weeds" that may grow around it.
