### Project #811: Spring Flowers!

- Cut out various sizes, shapes and lengths of stems for your flowers.
- Cut some leaf shapes.
- Cut petals shaped for the flower.
- Glue all pieces onto a collage type paper.
- Scrunch tissue paper to add textured pieces to your flowers.
- Make many flowers onto your paper.
- Draw some if you like.
- Add some magazine pictures by gluing them on.
- Stickers may also be used and some foam flower shapes. These often come with a peel off backing.
- You may also cut your kind of flower from foam pieces and glue them onto your creation.
- Add scenery if you like.
- Spray the creation with some lightly scented perfume or cologne.
- Add some pollen details as you may have flowers at home such as lilies which do drop pollen.
- Dandelions outdoors will also be dropping their seeds and are easy to find. Blow the dandelion seeds off the stem to collect the seeds for art!
- Use cupcake paper for the center of a flower.

#### Activity:

Walk to search for the real seeds of pollinating flowers. Collect some loose ones which have fallen or find the dandelions and blow the seed off and collect for your project.
