Project #812: Spring Looped Flowers and Daffodils!

- Cut some strips of colourful paper to form the loops for flower petals. Fold this over and pinch the edges together to form a loop for the flower petals.
- Cut flower stems and leaves from some green construction paper. These can be formed from scraps of paper and be various lengths and sizes.
- Glue the stems and leaves onto another piece of paper. Construction paper or poster board is nice for this.
- As a group, the children can make a large poster board of a garden or groups of flowers.
- Add some Daffodil type flowers to this.
- Cupcake paper would look good in the center for a daffodil which can be surrounded by the yellow daffodil paper leaves.
- Attach stems and leaves to these as well.
- On your paper, you may like to draw in more details.
- Make some scenery if you like adding grass, sky, clouds etc.

Activity: Growing and Planting!

Visit a Garden Center and purchase some seedling flowers. Prepare some soil in some small pots. Plant the seedlings carefully, water them and watch them grow. They will do well indoors to start by the window or on a sheltered patio outdoors.
