Project #815: "Perfume" Making!

- Gather some fresh flower petals that are scented.
- Place these scented flower petals into some lukewarm water and let sit for a few days.
- Place indoors in a neutral temperature area. Not too warm or cold.
- Stir them around gently from time to time.
- Check by smelling the water with the flower petals to see if it is becoming scented.
- When it is ready, take the flower petal out by straining this solution out into a bowl. Use a sifter for this.
- Note the colour of the "Perfumed Water"
- Pour you "Perfume into some small spray bottles.
- Spray onto your wrist to test the scent.
- Enjoy your natural "Perfume"!

Activity: Perfume Spray Ideas:

Use your new Perfume to spray onto projects such as when you make a Coffee filter flower or another art idea with a flower theme! Spray onto your arms. Compare various homemade perfume scents. Try various flowers to see which works the best. Add some real perfume to your creation if you would like an additional scent to smell how it changes.
