### Project #822: Spring and Baby Animals!

- Provide children with various shapes of cut out animals to colour or add details to such as wool, cotton, string, etc.
- The children may glue cotton on Rabbit shapes for example.
- Or the wool could also be the fur of a dog or a cat.
- Think of other texture mediums you may like to use for gluing onto the animal shapes.
- Supple some felt markers, and crayons.
- Painting with some lightweight smaller paint brushes can help with details of this project.
- Make larger animal shapes to place on a painting easel and use larger paint brushes.
- Felt markers are also great for easel coloring. Try some Bingo Dabbers for your easel creation.

**Books:** Read many animal books that are simple for the younger children.

**Songs:** Many songs such as “Old MacDonald Had a Farm”  
“Baa Ba Black Sheep” (try other colours)  
“Mary had a Little Lamb”  
“How much is that Doggie in the Window”
