Project #823: Spring Trees and Flowers!

- Provide a photo copy of a plain tree with branches.
- Children may add some green leaf shapes to show the tree starting to bloom with leaves.
- Add some pink, white and red tissue paper to create some blossoms for your tree.
- Tissue paper looks nice when scrunched as well to give the blossoms a 3D look.
- A flower booklet may be made as well.
- Make a booklet by folding and stapling construction paper to form a small booklet.
- Provide shapes for flowers and leaves.
- Children can design their own kind of booklet creating flowers of their own ideas. Use a glue stick.
- Try use some magazine, calendar or catalogue flowers for this project as well using a glue stick.
- If you would like your flowers to be scented, spray your booklet with some light perfumes or powders.

Books: Read many books on flowers and planting.

Walks: Go on a Springtime walk to view the blossoms, leaves and flowers. Gather some flower petals that may have fallen to the ground.
