Project #817: Easter Baskets!

(By Kids Care Preschool and South Van Family Place)

- Create a paper basket by folding up the sides of a square piece of poster board paper (Cut short slits on even intervals for the size of box you would like)
- Children can decorate this flat "box" with felt markers, pencils, crayons, stamps and stickers.
- Fold each side upward staple in place
- Or use some plain small boxes.
- Create a handle from some strong paper such as poster board as well. Staple or tape the Handle onto the box.
- Inside the finished Easter Basket, place some filling of soft paper such as you may buy in a store.
- You may also like to use cotton or tissue paper as a filling.
- These are ready for the Easter Egg Hunt!

Activity: Easter Egg Hunt!

Children may use these baskets to search for the Colourful Plastic eggs which may have a Treat or Craft inside them! Eggs could have stickers, tattoos. You may also have wrapped chocolate eggs for the hunt or paper eggs!
