### Project #827: Mother's Day Cards!

- Use some folded construction paper to make rectangle, square or tea pot shaped cards.
- Be sure the fold is on the left side of the card shape so you may open it from right to left.
- These cards can have a variety of cover page ideas and insert pages.
- Glue the cover page and insert into the cards. Children may like to do this. Use some strong glue sticks such as UHU. Some glue sticks may not support the paper, especially folded paper.
- Decorate the inside and outside any way the children like.
- Provide felt markers, crayons, stickers, glitter, flower shapes, heart shapes etc.
- Provide a short poem inside the card.
- If you are making a Teapot shaped card, place a covered teabag inside the card.
- Have some tea together.
