Project #830: Bird Nests!

- Provide a Bird in a Nest shape or shapes.
- Provide some sticker eyes or googly eye (child is 3 years and over) Googly eyes are not recommended for under 3 years old.
- Children may glue the nest shape onto a piece of construction paper.
- The basic shape of a baby bird or a few baby birds may be glued sticking out of the nest shape.
- Children may colour, add eyes, beaks and feathers to the birds.
- The "Nest" may be decorated with twigs, string, wool, straw or other natural nature items that a bird may use for a nest.
- Cotton that is stretched thinly may be nice to add to the nest.
- Children may like to add trees and grass, flowers etc. to their creation too!
- Grass could also be used for the outer part of the "Nest"

Activity: Bird Watching

Go for a walk, stop and listen. Look for birds and see what colours, sizes and shapes they are. If you walk by the river, you will see many ducks and geese. Soon they will be hatching the eggs. You may see the baby Ducks and Geese!
