### Project #831: Bird Projects!

- Provide children with a bird shape from various colours of construction paper.
- Older children could use a template of a bird shape to trace. They may want to cut around it and glue it onto another piece of construction paper.
- Provide googly eyes, sticker eyes, crayons, felt markers, pencil crayons plus stamps and stickers if you like.
- Glue sticks or non toxic liquid white glue are good for gluing feathers or pieces of string and wool for your bird shape/s
- Make a mobile with more than one bird shape. Attach your birds to a stick, rod or even a pipe cleaner with a short string/s.
- A group project could be on a large poster where many people can add their birds. Trying drawing some too.
- Add details to your collage.
- Provide magazine, catalogue and newspaper clippings of birds to add to a collage.
