Project #832: Frogs!

- Provide a Frog shape/s cut out of construction paper. Most frogs are green or brown.
- Provide sticker eyes, googly eyes, crayons, felt markers, and pencil crayons. Tissue paper is also a nice idea.
- Small bingo dabbers are great for the spots on the frogs.
- QTips may also work for the spots on the frogs.
- Frogs have a rough texture so try some thin sand paper circles or some bubby paper, or try some wallpaper sample pieces. Cut circles out for gluing onto your frog.
- If you like the older children may want to add foot details by drawing or sticking pieces on the toes of the frogs.
- Make a pond out of a blue poster board.
- Make some log shapes to put in the pond.
- Add some small or large frogs to the pond.

Five green and speckled frogs, sat on a speckled log,
