Project #842: Father's Day Drawing!

(Drawing samples: Kid's Care Preschool)

- Provide a plain piece of white paper.
- Provide felt markers, crayons, or pencil crayons for the children to draw their own father.
- Children may also draw a person that resembles the father they may not have.
- Encourage free drawing as this is their own creation. They may like to draw themselves and maybe other family members.
- They could draw, their house, pets etc as well.
- If you provide a photo of their Dad, it could be used for the child to view as they draw.
- What about the clothing Dad usually wears... Provide some ideas.
- Try looking into some catalogues for some ideas.
- Children may also like to add To: and From: or Love: and add their name.
- There are many printed ideas of verses that may also be used for this. Try glueing some printed materials onto this drawing.

Activity: Walk and Talk!

Go for a walk with your Dad and other Family members too. Have a picnic with Dad and Family. Have some solo time with Daddy and do things you both like to do! Talk about what interests you both have.
