Project #843: Father's Day Trophy Cards!

- Provide the printed shape of a trophy or cut out a trophy shape for Dad! It could be a folded card with a double Trophy shape.
- Provide a verse on it such as "Number 1 Dad!"
- Look for some other Father's Day verses that you may print out and glue on.
- Add some sparkles and stickers!
- Write your own verse to Dad.
- Adults can help with the printing or spelling when asking the child what they think of when they see Dad.
- Some children may comment on what Dad does. This could be work related, play related, family related, travel etc.
- Write these on the trophy or the child may like to add stickers to show what Dad likes to do.
- Add some hearts too if you like.

Activity: Trophy Parade!

Find some small trophies in a dollar store. Each Family member can join the parade with music and a small trophy. At the end of the procession, have Daddy accept the trophies from all family members. This can also be done with a group of friends for those who do not have a father or have a smaller family.
