### Project #840: Fish Aquarium!

- Cut the center out of a paper plate.
- Attached the remaining circle to another paper plate by taping, gluing or stapling it to be secure.
- In the center of your "Aquarium" colour it blue or paint it blue. Green is also used for water.
- Place some small paper fish into the coloured area.
- Add other details such as wavy lines, seaweed, rocks, barnacle and sand.
- You may like to sprinkle some real sand onto it.
- Try some coloured sand.
- Some sparkles would also look nice.
- Try some tissue paper for a seaweed look.
- If you would like to hang it up, use a hole puncher at the top.
- Then choose your ribbon or string to thread it through.

### Activity: Aquarium Visit!

Visit your local Aquarium to view the various sea creatures. Discuss what they need for food and the need they have for staying in the water. Talk about safety for the fish and yourself. Jelly Fish for example may be poisonous. Pet stores also may have Aquariums to view!
