Project #848: Back to School Bus!

- Cut out various shapes to create a School Bus.
- Be sure to include a large rectangle for the body,
- Small squares for the windows.
- Medium sized rectangle for the door.
- Small circles for the wheels.
- Provide some shiny paper for the flashings on your bus.
- Provide some bright yellow paper for the lights.
- You may want to add a small tailpipe.
- Sparkles will work well for the lights. Felt markers for details.
- Children may glue these pieces together to make their own idea of a bus. Be flexible as all children have different ideas.
- Try using some strips of black paper for accents to the bus.
- This can be created by gluing this bus together on a piece of construction paper.
