Project #849: Fire Truck!

(By Kids Care Preschool)

- Provide various shapes to create your fire truck.
- Be sure to include the ladder.
- Other shapes may be rectangles, squares, circles and strips of paper. Sparkles can be used for the lights of your project too!
- Be sure to provide shiny pieces of red paper for the flashing light on the top of your fire engine.
- Think about some hoses, perhaps they could be strips of paper or they could be some wool or string.
- A ladder can be a premade rectangle that the children may be able to draw the slats of the ladder.
- Think about the tools the Fire Fighters may use.
- Find some stickers regarding these tools such as emergency things like tools and medical equipment.
- They do wear safety masks as well. Find some stickers of the Fire Fighters.

Activity: Fire Hall Visit or Viewing

If you can plan a visit to the Fire Hall or have a Fire Fighter come into your School it would be very beneficial to the children. The children can learn and also be informed about details. Fire Fighters often wear masks which can be frightening for children. So seeing the Fire Fighter in the proper gear is important.
