Project #851: Acorns for Fall!

- Create the shape of the Acorn Nut
- Create the shape of the "Hat"
- Provide these shapes to the children so they may glue the "Hat" onto the Acorn Shape.
- Children may draw some crossing lines on the acorn as suggested or just colour it if they like. It is their project so their ideas are welcome!
- Try some outdoor textures such as scraps of Fall leaves.
- Try using some textures such as tissue paper or other textured paper for details. These scraps may be glued on.
- Try making a "Stem" to attach to your project.
- Qitp painting may work for the details and lines of the acorn.
- Staple two pieces together and Stuff with paper to have a 3D effect

Activity: Go for a Nature Walk:

Look for the acorns as it is Fall. You may find some on the ground and in the leaves that are falling. See what tree they fall from.
