Project #852: Fall Apples!

- Provide a Tree Trunk Shape.
- Provide a leafy top for the your Apple Tree
- Children may glue the pieces together.
- Once you have your tree ready, use some green tissue paper to add details to the leafy part of the tree.
- Use a glue stick to add some green scrunched small pieces of tissue paper to add details to the tree top.
- Add some small apple shapes by gluing them onto your tree.
- You may like to add some small paper leaf shapes.
- Draw some wiggly lines on the tree trunk, and use brown tissue paper for details too.
- If you like, glue the tree onto a piece of paper and make some scenery around it.

- Have many felt apple pieces.
- Share the apples with your family and friends.
